Blending practical and theoretical learning, the course covers key areas such as kitchen operations, barista skills, health and safety, customer service and employability training. Participants leave with the confidence and capabilities needed to launch successful careers in hospitality.

We are proud to share that 10 participants have already completed the first pilot course and are now ready to bring their skills into the industry.

Thanks to the success of the pilot and our ongoing partnership, a new cohort began on 31st of March 2025, with training opportunities now being offered on a monthly basis - empowering even more residents to pursue rewarding careers in hospitality.
